Course Level

The term **Course Level** is used as a guide for those determining whether they should participate in a technical course.

Beginner/Apprentice Level courses are designed for those that are just learning the HVAC trade and have little or no experience. The information will be elementary in nature, and it is assumed the participant has no knowledge of the subject matter.

Intermediate Level courses are designed for the experienced technician with one or two years of field and technician training. At this level the technician should know how to charge equipment and have moderate troubleshooting skills.

Advanced Level courses are designed for the technician with more than two years of field, technician, and supervisory experience. This level can be handled by mechanical engineers with HVAC experience. At this level the engineer or technician should have superior troubleshooting skills and be able to share information with supervised employees.

Course Location

We conduct training in Houston, Texas. Check the course schedule to be certain of the training location. ***Not all training classes are offered at all locations.*** Training locations are subject to change, but will be held in the same city in which it was scheduled.

NATE CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS COURSE CREDITS

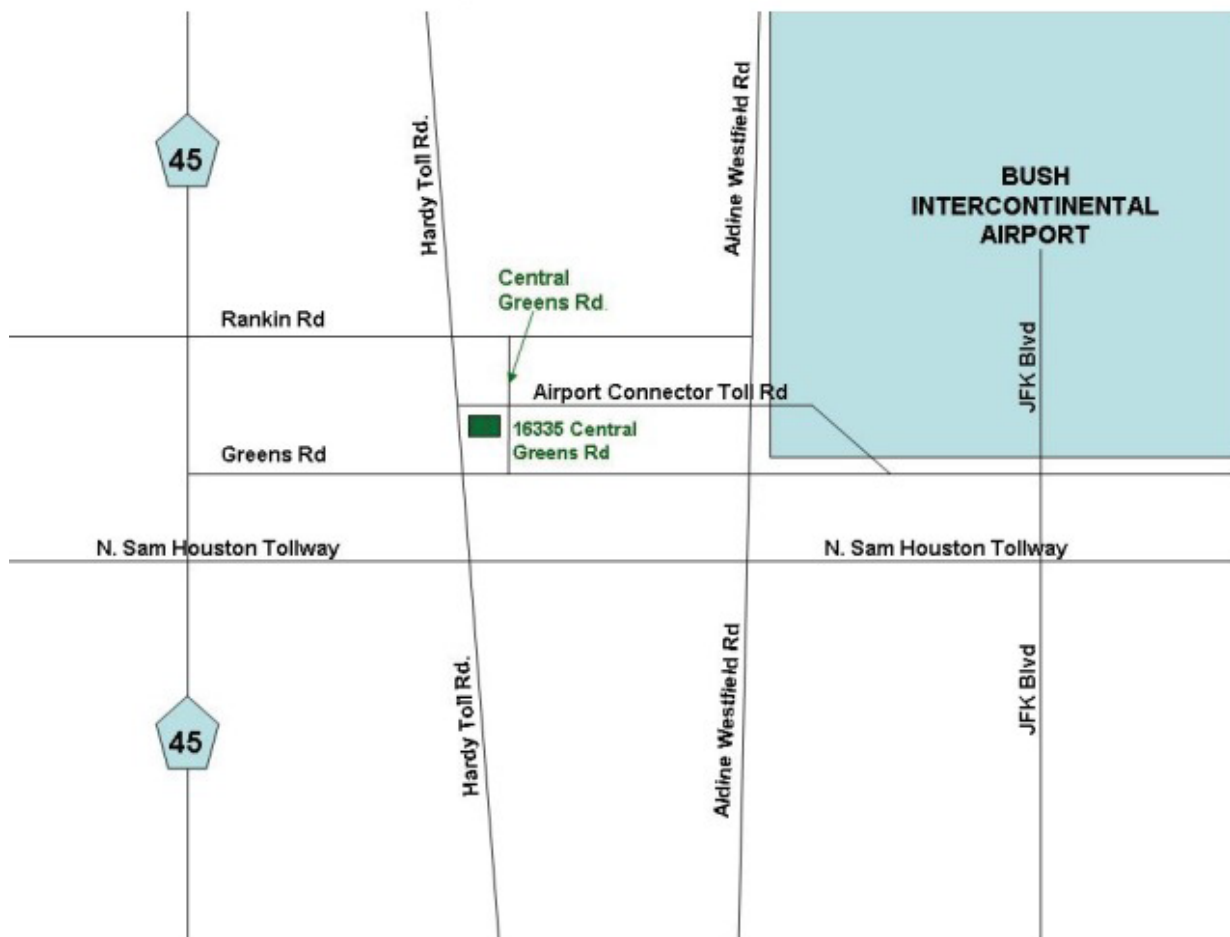
